

GB200 Golf Buggy Lock Fitting Instructions

FITTING



1. Ensure the brake is applied to the buggy.



2. With the lock removed place the cover over the accelerator pedal.



3. With the key in the lock in the unlocked position insert the lock into the housing.



4. Remove the key.

Should you wish to obtain additional keys, a local locksmith may be able to copy one of the original keys.
